We are writing to you as you are registered at Bath Street Medical Centre, 73 Bath Street, Sedgley, DY3 1LS.

The reason for the letter is to update you on the arrangements that your GP practice has put in place to guarantee your ongoing access to GP services following a recent Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection at Bath Street Medical Centre.

This letter confirms the arrangements that have been put in place to ensure your ongoing care at your GP practice.

Accessing GP services at Bath Street Medical Centre

Following a recent CQC inspection, arrangements have been made for an experienced GP partner from The Ridgeway Surgery in Sedgley to work alongside the existing practice staff to oversee clinical care and provide support.

The current GP partner, Dr Mahbub will not be able to provide clinical care during this period at Bath Street Medical Centre however, they are working with NHS Black Country Integrated Care Board (ICB) and the CQC to ensure improvements are made at the practice.
